ORDINANCE No. 185145

*Authorize a competitive solicitation for streetcar ticket vending machines. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland finds:

- 1. The Portland Streetcar Loop Project is currently under construction, with an anticipated opening in September 2012. The project includes construction of 28 new station platforms and up to 7 new streetcar vehicles.
- 2. The current system uses on-board ticket vending machines, which are planned to be included on the new streetcars currently in production. However, these machines do not have the capacity to handle credit/debit cards or the increased system demand that will result from the system expansion. Therefore, the expanded system requires off-board ticket vending machines for each station platform.
- 3. The estimated cost for off-board ticket vending machines is approximately \$700,000.
- 4. The Federal Transit Administration has provided \$75,000,000 in federal grant funds for the streetcar loop project to TriMet. The City of Portland is subrecipient of these funds, through City Contract # 30000943. Federal funds will be used to purchase ticket vending machines.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation seeks Council authorization for Procurement Services to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) resulting in a not-to-exceed contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive offer providing a not-to-exceed contract for the purchase of streetcar ticket vending machines.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase will unnecessarily delay the manufacture and installation of ticket vending machines; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
