# 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Attached is an ordinance to authorize a contract with Northwest Testing, Inc. in the amount of \$113,037 for the subject project.

RFP No. FAC019 for a consultant to provide special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center was issued October 26, 2011. Three proposals were received on November 16, 2011. A selection committee reviewed the proposals and selected Northwest Testing, Inc. to recommend for contract award.
