The Office will work the bureau's advisory committee to advise the Office on the creation of a city-wide and/or region-wide initiative to eliminate disparities and promote social justice is needed. The creation of the Office was made possible through a collaborative effort between the community and City of Portland staff, specifically through the Creation Committee. The Creation Committee is composed of over 30 members from community organizations and City staff and has advised the Commissioner and the Mayor in discussing issues of equity in Portland and in the crafting of the Office. Effective collaboration needs to continue to ensure the success of the Office and will be done so by the formation of a bureau advisory committee that will include members of the community and City of Portland staff.
