Appointments:

The Building Code Board of Appeal has three vacancies. Julie Chlupach has resigned from the Building Code Board of Appeal as of February 10, 2011. Julie was in the Public at Large position on the board and I am recommending Linda Barnes move from the alternate Architect position to the Public at Large position. I am also recommending Dave Spitzer fill the alternate Architect position vacated by Linda. Both partial terms will be from March 16, 2011 through February 21, 2012.

With these appointments, there is one remaining vacancy in the alternate Public at Large category. We will continue outreach efforts to fill the vacancy. I have enclosed an updated Building Code Board of Appeal membership list for your records.

Enclosure

Building Code Board of Appeals:

The Building Code Board of Appeals is authorized under Portland City Code 24.10.080 and the State of Oregon Structural Specialty Code. This board consists of three members appointed by the Mayor. The members must be qualified by experience and training to make decisions on matters pertaining to building construction. One member must be a builder and one member must be an architect. Appointment to the Board is for a three-year term. The Director of BDS is an ex officio member of the board, and is represented by one of the Senior or Chief Plans Examiners on the BDS staff.

The Building Code Board of Appeals hears appeals of building code issues which are appealed beyond the Administrative Appeals Board. The Appeals Board may affirm, annul or modify the action of BDS on the condition that substantially equivalent safety is provided generally conforming to national standards concerning fire prevention, fire safety measures, and building construction requirements for safety.

This board meets as appeals are received.
