The purpose of the agreement, OHSU subaward No. GRROE0147\_PPB, is for OHSU to provide funds to the Police Bureau. The Women's Strength Program Coordinator worked with research associates from OHSU and Portland State University (PSU) to develop a computer-based training module related to the prevention and handling of violent situations for In-Home Care workers. The terms of this agreement are retroactively effective September 1, 2010, through August 31, 2011.


