

# ORDINANCE No. 185242

- \* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$317,419 from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the Metropolitan Medical Response System (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Portland Fire & Rescue applied to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) for a grant in the amount of \$317,419 for the Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program (MMRS) on *April 7, 2010*; and
2. The OEM has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant from the MMRS to Portland Fire & Rescue in the amount of \$317,419 for emergency response medical supplies and equipment, planning meeting and conference travel; and
3. No matching funds are required.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), for the Metropolitan Medical Response System in the amount of \$317,419.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217  
Business Area – FR00  
Bureau Program Expenses - \$317,419

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of Portland Fire & Rescue of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OEM for MMRS grant, award number 10-181, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

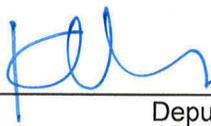
