

## TRN-3.406 - Transportation Services Fee and Rate Charges

### TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FEE AND RATE CHARGES

*Binding City Policy*

#### PURPOSE

1. The FY09/10 Approved Budget for the Bureau of Transportation includes revenues from cost of service recovery adjustments for the 12-month period beginning July 1, 2009. Transportation has consolidated changes for new and existing fee and rate charges into a schedule as set forth in "Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009", [Exhibit A](#) of this Ordinance. The schedule does not preclude the establishment and/or continuation of charges and fees by resolution, ordinance, code provision or administrative rule not otherwise specified in this Ordinance.

2. The City's Comprehensive Financial Management Policies (BCP-FIN-2.06) states: "The City will maximize and diversify its revenue base to raise sufficient revenue to support essential City services and to maintain services during periods of declining economic activity. City services providing private benefits should be paid for by fees and charges as much as possible to maximize flexibility in the use of City general revenue sources to meet the cost for services of broader public benefit... All bureaus charging fees are required to complete fee studies based upon cost-of-service principles." Transportation completed a cost of service review updating the 2006 cost of service model to reflect current costs of service.

3. Transportation's Budget Advisory Committee has thoroughly reviewed and approved Transportation's fee and rate charges. The City's Office of Management and Budget has reviewed and approved Transportation's updated service fees and fee development charge methodology as part of FY 2009/10 Approved Budget.

4. City Council has reviewed and approved these fee and rate charges as part of the FY 2009-10 budget process.

5. Transportation will distribute letters to permitted users and customers advising them of these pending fee and rate charges.

#### POLICY

a. The approval of fee and rate charges for Transportation services in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2009/10 Approved Budget, as set forth in the "Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009", attached [Exhibit A](#)

b. Transportation fee and rate charges shall be reviewed and approved by the City Transportation Director or his/her designee on an annual basis and adjusted to fully recover

the city's costs, taking into account permit issuance and renewal costs, inspection and oversight services that may be required, and equipment and resource utilization.

c. The City Transportation Director shall review on-street parking meter rates and short-term off-street City-owned parking garage rates on an annual basis and make recommendations for annual rate adjustments to City Council.

d. Increases to existing and new fee and rate charges reflected in [Exhibit A](#) "Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009" will become effective 30 days, after Council approval, on July 13, 2009.

e. This ordinance, including [Exhibit A](#) "Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009", is binding city policy.
