- 7. **BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:** Ordinance Number 183881 adopted on June 9, 2010, authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the Road Rehabilitation 2010 SE Clinton Street Project.
- 8. <u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The estimated project cost was \$844,535.91. Per the bid submission, the total amount for this project is \$697,697.00. Funds are available in the Portland Bureau of Transportation 2010-2011 fiscal year budget under Owner Cost Object 9TR000001366.
- 9. <u>**RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:**</u> Accept Recommendation to award contract to Kodiak Pacific Construction in the amount of \$697,697.00.
- 10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT</u>: The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to construct street improvements along SE Clinton from SE 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SE 49<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Work shall include, but not be limited to, the construction, maintenance and removal of temporary work zone traffic and erosion control measures, performance of earthwork removal operations, construction of drainage systems including sewer pipes and inlets, roadway improvements including cold planning, aggregate base, PCC base, HMAC wearing surfaces and concrete curbs, pavement markings and striping placement and additional incidental work as called for by the specifications and plans.

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
