#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Outside Counsel was required in the matter of <u>Kelly Shepard v City of Portland</u> et al, due to a conflict of interest.

Due to partnership agreements within the firm of Hoffman Hart LLC, the name has been changed to reflect these agreement. The new name of the firm is Hart Wagner LLC.

As the case has progressed, we find that it will be going to trial To continue paying outside counsel for their representation, it is necessary to increase the amount of the contract by \$50,000, for a total not to exceed \$230,000. Barring unforeseen activities, it is anticipated that this increase will be sufficient through the conclusion of the matter.
