

ORDINANCE No. 185299

Authorize a contract with BergerABAM Inc. for engineering services for the design of the Skidmore and Safeway Pump Station Upgrades Project Nos. E10291 and E10292 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional engineering services for the design of the Skidmore and Safeway Pump Station Upgrades, project numbers E10291 and E10292.
2. The services were advertised under RFP BES122 and 7 responsive proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected BergerABAM.
3. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with BergerABAM with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$345,520.
4. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is \$117,820, or 34.1% of the total contract amount.
5. Sufficient funding resides in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2012 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Elements E10291 and E10292.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with BergerABAM for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$345,520.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to BergerABAM chargeable to the Bureau of Environmental Services when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.




