- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 183328 adopted on November 12, 2009, authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the Southwest and East Portland Sidewalk Infill American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Project.
- 8. <u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The estimated project cost was \$1,303,856.97. Per the bid submission, the total amount is \$899,367.50. Funds for this project are available in the Bureau of Transportation FY 2009-10 Budget and are Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds administered by ODOT, WBS T00181.C42; T00182.C42, and; T00183.C42 respectively.
- 9. <u>RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:</u> Accept Recommendation to award contract to D&D Concrete & Utilities, Inc. in the amount of \$899,367.50.
- **10.** <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT</u>: The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to complete the construction of drainage, median islands and sidewalk improvements along sections of NE Glisan Street, NE and SE 82nd Avenue, and SW Barbur Boulevard as shown in the project plan set. Improvements shall consist of constructing, maintaining and removing temporary work zone traffic and erosion control measures; removing structures and obstructions; clearing, grubbing and performing earthwork operations; constructing drainage systems including water quality facilities, sewer pipes and inlets; constructing segmental

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retaining walls, concrete curb, driveways, median islands and sidewalks; placing pavement markings, striping and signing; constructing roadside development including seeding, fencing and mailboxes; and performing additional and incidental work as called for by the specifications and plans.
