

Assessment Methodology: Trip Volume

- Median Assessment \$9,963
- Assessment Range \$159 Minimum, \$183,477 Maximum
- 23.4% Below Estimate at LID Formation

Value Engineering

- First (Unsuccessful) Petition \$3,022,000
- Second (Successful) Petition \$2,407,000
- Final Amount \$1,844,000 Excluding Extra Work

Project Benefits

- Connects North and South Sides of Columbia Slough
- Provides Secondary Access South of Columbia Slough

Original Existing Vehicle Bridge

Existing Vehicle Bridge

- Built for \$17,690 in 1961 by Multnomah County
- Originally planned to be demolished and replaced
