(3) Ensure that any subawards comply with the standards in Section 210(a)-(d) of OMB Circular

A-133 and are not used to acquire commercial goods or services for the recipient;

(4) Ensure that any subawards are awarded to eligible subrecipients and that proposed subaward costs are necessary, reasonable, and allocable;

(5) Ensure that any subawards to 501(c)(4) organizations do not involve lobbying activities;

(6) Monitor the performance of their recipients and ensure that they comply with all applicable regulations, statutes, and terms and conditions which flow down in the subaward;

(7) Obtain EPA's consent before making a subaward to a foreign or international organization, or a subaward to be performed in a foreign country; and

(8) Obtain approval from EPA for any new subaward work that is not outlined in the approved work plan in accordance with 40 CFR Parts 30.25 and 31.30, as applicable.
