## ORDINANCE NO.

Amend the Regional Water Sales Agreement with the City of Sandy for the wholesale connection at Hudson's Intertie (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002666)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 182880, adopted by Council on June 3, 2009, authorized the Mayor and the Commissioner-in-Charge to enter into and sign a Regional Water Sales Agreement with the City of Sandy.
- 2. Per a request from the City of Sandy, it is their desire to take delivery of water from the Water Bureau at the Hudson's Intertie site. In order to comply with the City of Sandy's request the Regional Water Sales Agreement must be amended.
- 3. The Regional Water Sales Agreement is anticipated to generate almost \$500,000 in revenue over a four year period, starting with FY 2012-13 and will continue to generate revenue for at least the life of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner-in-Charge are authorized to execute on behalf of the City an amendment to the Regional Water Sales Agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Water Bureau Administrator and Auditor are authorized on behalf of the City of Portland to collect revenue from the City of Sandy, for the Water Sales Agreement, and deposit that revenue into the Water Fund.
