

I. RECOMMENDATION. Amend boundaries of Portland State University franchise, and amend franchise regarding insurance requirements (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 177529).

II. BACKGROUND. PSU's franchise allows it to operate a telecommunications and electrical system using the public streets within a specified boundary. The franchise designated the system's operating area as being within the then existing campus boundary, generally described as SW Market to the north, SW 4th Avenue to the east and Interstate 405 as it curves around the south and west. This area is commonly known as the University District.

In June 2008, the City Council approved an amendment to PSU's franchise to expand PSU's boundaries to encompass an area generally bounded by SW Market Street to the north, SW 3rd Avenue to the east, and Interstate 405 as it curves around the south and west of the campus back to SW Market Street.

In September 2009, the City Council approved an amendment to PSU's franchise to revise PSU's franchise boundaries to address campus growth and amend the franchise to include University District heating and cooling services.



Since the amendment was approved in 2009, PSU has acquired or is using properties outside the campus boundary. The Office for Community Technology recommends that the Council amend the franchise to revise the franchise boundaries to encompass these additional properties and to amend PSU's insurance requirements.
