7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This is a claim for bodily injury resulting from an automobile accident that occurred on May 26, 2011, on SE Grand near SE Morrison. A City vehicle driven by an employee of the Portland Police PAL hit the Speckman vehicle in a rear end collision. Beraly Speckman was a passenger, and was injured in the accident.

Liability on the part of the City's driver is clear. Risk Management resolved the general damages with the claimant's attorney for \$3,000. Farmers Insurance had a subrogation claim for medical expenses it paid on Beraly Speckman's behalf under its Personal Injury Protection ("PIP") coverage. Risk Management negotiated a settlement with Farmers for \$2,500. This Ordinance is to pay that negotiated settlement to Farmers Insurance.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in payments from the liability fund totaling \$5,500, consisting of the \$3,000 previously paid, and the balance of \$2,500 for PIP reimbursement being paid under this Ordinance.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Beraly Speckman injury claim in the sum of \$5,500.
