4. History of Agenda Item/Background:

A petition to vacate a portion of NW Vaughn Street was certified by the City Auditor's Office on May 2, 2011. The street vacation is proposed in order to consolidate property. If the vacation is approved, the petitioners may consider constructing a garage on this piece of land. The proposed vacation is depicted on Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

Comments were solicited from City Bureaus, government agencies, public utilities and affected neighborhood associations. No substantive objections were received.

The Planning and Sustainability Commission reviewed and approved the proposed street vacation on February 14, 2012.

An Engineer's Report was completed on May 8, 2012, recommending approval of the street vacation, subject to certain conditions and reservations. The Report, inclusive of the Planning and Sustainability Commission recommendation, will be forwarded to your office under separate cover, along with a recommended Street Vacation Ordinance for consideration by City Council.
