ORDINANCE No. 185503

Provide for civil forfeiture of property that is instrumentality or proceeds of money laundering (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 14B.50)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City is authorized by City Code Chapter 14B.50 to civilly forfeit property associated with certain crimes, but money laundering is not among them.
- 2. State civil forfeiture law authorizes cities to enact ordinances providing for the civil forfeiture of property that constitutes proceeds or instrumentalities of crime as described in ORS 161.515. (ORS 131A.010(4))
- 3. Money laundering crimes are undertaken to conceal the proceeds of unlawful activity and the proceeds and instrumentalities of money laundering crimes escape taxation.
- 4. Laundering a Monetary Instrument (ORS 164.170) and Engaging in a Financial Transaction in Property Derived from Unlawful Activity (ORS 164.172) are crimes as described in ORS 161.515.
- 5. Proposed Section 14B.50.050 declares moneys involved in the activities defined in ORS 164.170 and ORS 164.172 to be subject to forfeiture, as limited by Section 14B.50.020.
- 6. Proposed Section 14B.50.055 provides prioritization for the distribution of proceeds from money laundering forfeiture.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. City Code Chapter 14B.50 is hereby amended by adding Sections 14B.50.050 and 14B.50.055 as described in Exhibit A.
