The FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget includes \$186,000 for the operations and maintenance of this facility as well as \$218,000 for the initial tenant improvements. Of this \$404,000 budget, \$360,000 will be funded through a Special Appropriations transfer from the General Fund with the remaining \$44,000 coming from the Water Bureau through an Interagency Agreement. Future operating costs are estimated at \$219,000 annually.

7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Resolution No. 36863 passed by Council on May 25, 2011 affirmed designating the SFC Jerome Sears US Army Reserve Center for use as a west side emergency operations center for the City.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has reviewed and approved the City's application, authorizing transfer of the property for use as an emergency operations facility at no cost. The FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget for the Facilities Services Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services includes appropriation for the initial one-time and operating expenses related to this building.
