ORDINANCE No.

Add Oregon 529 College Savings Plan to the list of organizations eligible to use the City employee payroll deduction system (Ordinance; amend Code Section 5.08.140)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon 529 College Savings Network was established and is administered by the State of Oregon to help families and individuals save for future higher education expenses.
- 2. The Oregon 529 College Savings Network offers the Oregon 529 College Savings Plan, which provides state and federal tax advantages to help encourage families to save for the higher education expenses of designated beneficiaries.
- 3. The Oregon 529 College Savings Plan is governed by Section 529 of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 4. The Oregon 529 College Savings Plan can be purchased directly without using a financial advisor.
- 5. The Oregon 529 College Savings Plan should be added to the list of organizations eligible to use the City employee payroll deduction system under Code Section 5.08.140 Salary Deduction.
- 6. It is in the City's interest to add Oregon 529 College Savings Plan to the list of organizations eligible to use the City employee payroll deduction system not required to pay the fee described in Subsection B.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to add the Oregon 529 College Savings Plan to the list of organizations eligible to use the City employee payroll deduction system under Code Section 5.08.140 Salary Deduction and not required to pay the fee described in Subsection B.
- b. City Code 5.08.140 Subsection A shall be amended by **adding** a new organization as follows:
- 48. Oregon 529 College Savings Plan
- c. City Code 5.08.140 Subsection C shall be amended by <u>substituting</u> the following Subsection for existing Subsection C:

The entities or agencies whose names are preceded by the numbers described herein shall not be required to pay the fee described in Subsection B.: 1., 2., 3., 4., 5., 6., 10., 11., 12.,

13., 14., 15., 16., 17., 18., 19., 20., 21., 22., 23., 24., 25., 26., 31., 32., 35., 36., 43., 44., 45., 46., 47. and 48.
