

 Build the commercial, industrial, and residential markets for cost-saving energy efficiency improvements through incentives, technical assistance, policy and education




# Climate Action Plan 2030 Objective

- Spurs investment in energy efficiency projects
- Free to benchmark, need PE to certify



- Preceded by 4 years of Office Energy Showdown
- Started Fall 2010, ended May 2012
- 74 participating office buildings, including 47 in Portland
- Saved \$1.2 million in energy costs and 15.3 million kWh in 2011
- Free Energy Star certification by professional engineer
- Free scoping study from NEAA
- Connections to other incentives from Energy Trust and BPS




