

# ORDINANCE No. 18555<sup>2</sup>

Repeal Portland City Code Chapter 2.10 pertaining to the Campaign Finance Fund (Ordinance; repeal Code Chapter 2.10)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Chapter 1.01 of the City Charter requires the Auditor to maintain the City Code.
2. It is in the interest of all who rely upon the City Code to keep it as accurate and up-to-date as possible.
3. According to City Code Section 2.10.240, Code Chapter 2.10 applies only to elections taking place on or before November 2, 2010.
4. City Council referred measure 26-108 to the voters at the November 2, 2010 General Election as measure 26-108. The measure would have allowed the Campaign Finance Fund code to remain effective after the November 2010 election.
5. The electorate of Portland did not approve measure 26-108 and therefore, Code Chapter 2.10 does not apply to any future elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. City Code Chapter 2.10 is hereby repealed.
- b. The repeal of Code Chapter 2.10 shall not affect any claims of the City that have been reduced to a judgment.
