

ORDINANCE No. 185563

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Portland Development Commission for compliance and other services for Equal Employment Opportunity, Business and Workforce Equity Programs and the South Waterfront Central District (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City has been providing compliance services on PDC's Business & Workforce Equity Programs for over 15 years. Procurement Services provides PDC staff with reports on project outcomes, number of Minority, Women and Emerging Small Businesses used on the projects, and data on the workforce used to complete the projects
2. The PDC wishes to continue this relationship with the City for fiscal year 2012-13.

The proposed IGA would permit the City to provide compliance services, data entry services, monthly participation and statistical reports, and outreach services on assigned PDC projects for construction and professional services. The City will continue to provide compliance services on the South Waterfront including the new OUS and OHSU Collaborative Life Sciences Building.

3. The PDC has authorized its participation in the attached IGA.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Portland Development Commission, and any future annual renewals for a period of not to exceed five years. The Agreement shall be in a form substantially similar to the proposed IGA that is attached as Exhibit A.


