The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) has requested to purchase a new addition to the Fleet (N13002) for the additional maintenance associated with the expanded street car line. The purchase price is estimated at \$31,000 and PBOT will provide funding for the purchase of this equipment. Based on estimated usage, the repair and maintenance expenses are estimated to be \$670 and annual fuel costs totaling \$620 per year. Annual replacement costs will be \$3,092. Charges for replacement, fuel and repair services occur in accordance with the interagency agreement between CityFleet and PBOT. The present interagency agreement for FY 2013 does not include operational costs associated with this equipment and the agreement will have to be adjusted upon receipt of the new equipment.
