As a result TriMet's reimbursement to the City as authorized in paragraph 6.1 of the Intergovernmental Agreement

will be reduced by \$310,000.

The existing Intergovernmental Agreement authorized several tasks to be constructed as part of the SW Moody Project and SW Harbor Drive Improvement Project, for which TriMet would reimburse the City. Several of these tasks will now be constructed by TriMet as part of the Portland-Milwaukie Light Rail Project. As a result the City's reimbursement to TriMet as authorized in paragraph 6.3 of the Intergovernmental Agreement will be increased by \$790,000. The level of confidence is high.
