7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Ordinance No. 161964, adopted by Council on May 24, 1989, established standards and guidelines for conducting charitable fund-raising campaigns and authorized the use of the payroll deduction system for making donations to charities.

In 2013, 15 agencies and foundations are being recommended to participate in the 2013 Combined Charitable Campaign. These agencies include:

- All Hands Raised (formerly Portland Schools Foundation)
- America's Charities
- Black United Fund of Oregon
- Children's Trust Fund of Oregon
- Community Health Charities of Oregon
- Earth Share of Oregon
- **Equity Foundation**
- Global Impact
- Local Independent Charities
- McKenzie River Gathering Foundation
- Portland Fire Bureau Toy & Joymakers
- Portland Parks Foundation
- Work for Art (Regional Arts & Culture Council)
- Sunshine Division of the Portland Police Bureau
- United Way of the Columbia-Willamette

The requirement of Code Section 5.10 that the participating agencies be umbrella organizations was waived for the Portland Toy & Joymakers, who received a five year exemption from the umbrella requirement in 2011.

The requirement of Code Section 5.10 that the participating agencies be umbrella and not exceed 25 percent of their unrestricted income was waived for one year for the Portland Parks Foundation in 2011.

The Portland Parks Foundation has since been compliant with the 25 percent requirement and is therefore eligible to participate again. The Committee is seeking an umbrella organization exemption for the Portland Parks Foundation.

All other participating agencies have met the Code requirements outlined in Code Section 5.10. The City's Charitable Campaign Committee recommends that Council approve the participation of these organizations in the 2013 Campaign.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

I recommend that you approve this ordinance for the participation of the above 15 agencies and foundations, and grant the Portland Parks Foundation and umbrella organization exemption.
