TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 114361 for the Rose City Sewer Rehabilitation Project for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of \$6,100,000. The Bureau of Environmental Services rated the level of project estimate confidence as Optimal.

Bids were opened on September 11, 2012, and Five (5) bids were received. The low bid of Moore Excavation, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. It is recommended that the bid of Moore Excavation, Inc. be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$5,924,745.00.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified twelve (12) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$1,067,701.47 awarded to subcontractors.


