

ORDINANCE NO. 185703

* Authorize a grant agreement for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 to the Oregon Food Bank to provide food for families in need (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

1. Oregon Food Bank (OFB) is the hub of a statewide network of 20 regional food banks and 947 nonprofit, hunger-relief agencies and programs serving Oregon and Clark County, Washington.
2. OFB works to eliminate the root causes of hunger through advocacy, nutrition education, learning gardens and public education.
3. OFB last year collected and distributed 45 million pounds of food, a 12 percent increase over the previous year. In total, the OFB Network distributed 81 million pounds of food.
4. In accordance with the City Council's Special Appropriations for FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget, the City now desires to make a grant to Oregon Food Bank in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement for \$100,000 in one-time funds to Oregon Food Bank substantially in conformance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to the original of this Ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to Special Projects fund when demand is presented and approved by proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing grant funding to allow Oregon Food Bank to expeditiously proceed with procuring appropriate services would harm the public interest; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


