*Authorize CityFleet to replace forty-seven Police Patrol sedans for \$1,437,113 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the Police Patrol sedans.
- 3. It has been determined that forty-seven Patrol sedans need to be replaced for Police Exhibit A attached.
- 4. The cost of these vehicles is \$30,576.88 each, or \$1,437,113.36 for forty-seven patrol sedans.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into the contract and any subsequent amendments on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1.
- b. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the successful contractor chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchases would result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of these vehicles at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
