7.BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) requested the creation of the new classification of Statistician in order to describe the specific duties of one full-time, permanent position responsible for the application of statistics and statistical methods used to design studies related to the water quality, hydrology, and ecology of watersheds in the City of Portland. The BES Statistician is responsible for statistical study designs, data management, data analysis, research and communication of results. The Bureau of Human Resources is recommending a Nonrepresented salary grade 8 for the Statistician.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no direct cost to create this new classification. One regular, full-time Environmental Specialist position will be reclassified to the new Statistician classification at a salary grade 8, which has a maximum salary that is \$3,390 higher.
