- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS This agreement for outside legal counsel is being renewed for a final payment for legal support to City Attorney staff for the Portland Harbor Superfund Site work. In addition to supporting ongoing legal issues, this agreement has included services regarding historical insurance policy coverage and related expert and research support. There are no controversial issues associated with this contract. The Portland Harbor Superfund Site is a complex multi-agency/multi-party project involving a wide range of legal and technical issues. The work under this contract involves confidential legal issues and is subject to the attorney-client privilege. It does not involve citizen participation. City Attorney and Bureau of Environmental Services staff work regularly with state and federal regulatory and natural resource agencies.
