### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On September 1, 2011, the Bureau of Transportation had a locate request from PGE for the corner of SE 86<sup>th</sup> and Stark, where PGE was replacing a utility pole. PGE was informed no city utilities were in the ground at the locate site. When PGE drilled at the site for the new pole, they hit the sewer lateral for the building at the corner. This resulted in damage to the adjoining property and to PGE facilities. The property owner's claim was previously settled by Risk Management.

PGE later submitted a detailed invoice to the City for recovery of their expenses. Risk Management has reviewed the invoice and spoken with PGE about the charges. Risk Management believes these charges are reasonable and appropriate, and we feel this bill should be paid, as the damages are a direct result of the City's failure to locate the city sewer pipe. The invoice totals \$15,500.

### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$15,500 from the liability fund.

Approve settlement of PGE Property damage Claim in the sum of \$15,500.
