ORDINANCE No. 185978

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University in the amount of \$44,432 to implement the project Portland Residential Waste Sorts 2013 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Both the State of Oregon and the City of Portland have adopted aggressive waste reduction goals that rely on increasing recycling for all sectors.
- 2. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) partners with private recycling and composting facilities to meet recycling goals, and it is imperative to deliver clean streams to these facilities.
- 3. Placing inappropriate materials and waste into recycling and composting collection containers presents serious issues for processing contamination of commercially valuable recyclable and compostable materials.
- 4. In 2013 PSU will provide services to BPS to analyze the residential recycling, composting, and garbage collection to determine the material composition of all three collection programs used by single-family residences. Data gathered by PSU will inform policy makers on the success rate for recovery of recyclable and compostable materials and suggest ways to improve recycling and composting collection efforts.
- 5. Funds are available in the adopted FY 2012-2013 budget of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, SAP Code PNSD000006. Additional funds are requested in the FY 2013-2014 budget for BPS.

NOW, THEREFORE,

- a. The Mayor is authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a total amount of \$44,432 with PSU in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to this Ordinance.
- b. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the agreement provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to allow continuing work analyzing the successful diversion of recyclable materials from waste collection. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
