

ORDINANCE No. 186007

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$55,942, appropriate \$28,462 for FY 2012-13 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team sworn personnel expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Multnomah County Family Violence Coordinating Council partners applied to the Department of Justice (DOJ) Office on Violence Against Women (OVAW) Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders (GTEAP) program for a grant in the amount of \$649,981 for the DVERT program in September 2012; and
2. Multnomah County Department of County Human Services (MCDCHS) has notified the City that it will award a sub-recipient grant for the DVERT program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$55,942; and
3. The purpose of Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), MC #4400000331/COP #30003265, is for Multnomah County to provide funds to the City so the Police Bureau may fund 0.5 FTE DVERT Sergeant for six months and 0.3 FTE for 15 months; and
4. Authorization of Intergovernmental Agreement, MC #4400000331/COP #30003265, stipulates the County will reimburse the City, as sub-grantee, for approved program expenses not to exceed \$55,942 and is conditioned upon both parties' agreement to the attached IGA; and
5. The grant period is January 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014; and
6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ and MCDCHS.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from MCDCHS for the 2012 Department of Justice (DOJ) Office on Violence Against Women (OVAW) Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders (GTEAP) program in the amount of \$55,942.

- c. The FY 2012-13 budget is hereby amended as follows:
GRANTS FUND
Fund - 217
Business Area - PL
Bureau Program Expenses - \$28,462
- d. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- e. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Multnomah County Department of County Human Services for the 2012 DOJ OVAW GTEAP grant, #2012-WE-AX-0020, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ and MCDCHS. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

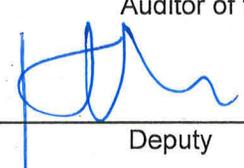
