New roadway and sidewalk crossings at SE 8<sup>th</sup>, SE 11<sup>th</sup> and SE 12<sup>th</sup> Avenues will be constructed as part of TriMet's Portland-Milwaukie Light Rail Project. The agreements permit the City to utilize Union Pacific Railroad right of way for the new public roadway and sidewalk crossings, and address future maintenance obligations.

The City will be responsible for operations and maintenance of the new at-grade roadway crossings in accordance with ODOT Crossing Orders 50979 and 50980. Funding for future maintenance is expected to come from General Transportation Revenues. The City currently has maintenance responsibility for the existing at-grade crossings in this vicinity so the impact of future operations and maintenance is anticipated to be negligible.

TriMet has paid for right of way acquisition and is responsible for construction costs.
