BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 185865 passed by the Council on January 23, 2013 and authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the SE 2nd Avenue, SE 3rd Avenue & SE Alder St Consolidation Project. There are numerous cracks, broken joints, sags and partial collapse in the 10" sewer line on SE 2nd Avenue and the 8" sewer line on SE 3rd Avenue that warrants immediate repair. The intersection of SE 3rd and Alder needs to be rehabilitated after the completion of the East Side CSO project. In order to relieve capacity issues in the South East Interceptor (SEI), a diversion structure must be constructed near the intersection of SE Alder St and SE 6th Avenue to connect two vertically separated, parallel combined sewer lines.
- 8. <u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: The engineer's estimate for this project was \$2,000,000 and the confidence level was Optimal. Funding for this project is available in FY 12/13 Budget under WBS Element E08847.C60.
- **9.** <u>**RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:** Accept Recommendation to award contract to Rio Underground, LLC in the amount of \$2,024,730.</u>

10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT</u>: The SE 2nd Ave, SE 3rd Ave & SE Alder St Consolidation Project includes three projects which are the SE 2nd Ave & SE 3rd Ave Sewer Replacement, the SE 3rd Ave and SE Alder Intersection Restoration and the SE Interceptor relief at SE Alder St and SE 6th Ave. The project involves construction of sewer lines along SE 2nd Ave between SE Alder St and SE Stark St and along SE 3rd Ave between SE Washington and SE Alder Street. Construction of pavement, curbs, sidewalks, ADA corner ramps and storm inlets at the intersection of SE 3rd Ave and SE Alder St. Construction of a manhole diversion structure to connect two vertically aligned pipes along SE Alder between SE 6th Ave and SE Grand Ave.
