

ORDINANCE No. 186161

Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$518,240 from the Department of Homeland Security, through its Federal Emergency Management Agency for the purchase of individual facepieces for firefighter's self-contained breathing apparatus. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) applied to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through its Federal Emergency Management Agency for a grant in the amount of \$518,240 for the purchase of individual facepieces for firefighter's self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) on July 6, 2012; and
2. DHS has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the purchase of SCBA facepieces to PF&R in the amount of \$518,240; and
3. Local match in the amount of \$129,560 will be provided by funds from the FY 2013-2014 operations budget of Portland Fire & Rescue.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the DHS for the purchase of individual SCBA facepieces in the amount of \$518,240.
- b. The FY 2013-2014 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217
Business Area – FR
Bureau Program Expenses– \$518,240

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- d. The Fire Chief of PF&R, of the City of Portland, is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by DHS for Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, EMW-2012-FO-07094, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.


