ORDINANCE No. 186207

*Authorize grant agreement with Hacienda Community Development Corporation to develop an implementation plan to achieve equity and carbon emission reduction outcomes within the Villa de Clara Vista multi-family low income rental property. (Ordinance)

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. On March 13, 2013, by Ordinance 185919, City Council authorized acceptance of \$25,000 in funds from the Bullitt Foundation to integrate social equity metrics and outcomes into the Climate Action Plan. Of the \$25,000 total, \$15,000 was designated to pass-through to Hacienda Community Development Corporation (Hacienda CDC) to develop a detailed implementation plan for achieving these goals within Villa de Clara Vista, a multi-family low income rental property owned by Hacienda CDC.
- 2. Hacienda CDC is a nonprofit that seeks to strengthen families by providing affordable housing, homeownership support, economic advancement and educational opportunities. It works to transform underserved Portland neighborhoods by reclaiming crime-ridden and decayed properties.
- 3. Providing \$15,000 of the Bullitt Foundation grant funds to Hacienda CDC supports the goals of the Climate Action Plan and the Portland Plan.
- 4. Grant funding is requested in the budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability for Fiscal Year 2013-2014, Code Object number PN00400001.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City in accordance with Exhibit A to provide \$15,000 to Hacienda CDC to develop a detailed implementation plan for achieving equity and carbon outcomes in the rebuilding of Villa de Clara Vista, a multi-family low income rental property owned by Hacienda CDC. Funds authorized by Ordinance 185919.
- b. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is directed to carry out the grant agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that the City and Hacienda can meet the timelines in the grant award from the Bullitt Foundation. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
