* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham, Oregon for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2013 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will provide grant funding under the FY 2013 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program;
- 2. The JAG Program supports the purpose areas of law enforcement programs, prosecution programs, prevention and education programs and technology improvement programs;
- 3. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as applicant and fiscal agent for the disparate municipalities. The City wishes to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Gresham to obligate agency roles and responsibilities;
- 4. The City will, with USDOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse the City of Gresham for the cost of all approved program expenses not to exceed \$56,391.00;
- 5. This agreement shall begin July 1, 2013, and extend through September 30, 2016, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from USDOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this authorization would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from USDOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
