

**ORDINANCE No. 186246**

Authorize a Memorandum of Understanding between the U.S. Coast Guard and the Portland Police Bureau to transfer and destroy narcotics (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Bureau (PPB) has consistently worked in mutual aid partnerships with federal and state law enforcement agencies.
2. PPB and the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) have a mutual interest in transferring, destroying, and documenting personal use quantities of narcotics.
3. USCG has no way to dispose of narcotics that are seized from vessels within the Portland area that are no longer needed as evidence.
4. PPB has the necessary destruction equipment.
5. USCG will maintain all evidence in accordance with evidence control policies.
6. All materials will be transferred from USCG to PPB in accordance with evidence control transfer policies.
7. PPB will destroy all evidence in accordance with PPB policy.
8. This is a five year agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge of the Police Bureau and the Chief of Police are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Coast Guard substantially in accordance with the attached Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge of the Police Bureau and the Chief of Police are hereby authorized to enter into subsequent modifications to the agreement, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge of the Police Bureau and the Chief of Police are hereby authorized to enter into and amend subsequent intergovernmental agreements for this purpose with the U.S. Coast Guard, provided such agreements do not increase the City's

financial obligation or risk. Any agreements or modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
