7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

<u>Introduction and History</u> — The proposed ordinance will authorize the Public Finance and Treasury Division of the Office of Management and Finance (OMF) to provide technical assistance on new financing programs or proposals, and assistance and expertise in compliance programs (debt management services) requested by the Portland Development Commission (PDC) and to submit billings and invoices to PDC for such work.

The proposed ordinance delegates to the Chief Administrative Officer of the Office of Management and Finance the authority to execute amendments to this Agreement on behalf of OMF, provided such agreements are in writing, signed by both Parties, and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
