#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

October 17, 2013

This ordinance would settle a lawsuit brought in state court by Maria Sosa against the City of Portland for bodily injury suffered when her vehicle was struck from the rear by a vehicle driven by a Portland Water Bureau employee on December 13, 2010. This settlement amount of \$35,000 will be paid to Ms. Sosa and her attorney John Uffelman for economic and non-economic damages including pain and suffering.
