## **ORDINANCE No.** 186324

\*Accept and appropriate an amendment to grant agreement with Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management in the additional amount of \$10,253 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City (Ordinance; amend Agreement No. 12-529)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. The Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) provides financial and technical assistance through their Fiscal Year 2012 grant. These funds are provided for the development of an all hazard emergency management capability to promote planning, response, exercise, training and community outreach.
- 2. Council authorized acceptance of grant #12-529 via ordinance 185855 on January 16, 2013.
- 3. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM), which administers the grant to Portland for FEMA, is amending the grant agreement to extend the award period to August 31, 2013 and add \$10,253.00.
- 4. Grant funds are budgeted for one half of the cost of three Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) positions, one half of the annual rent for PBEM office space, one half of plan development software and one half of the total cost of Emergency Coordination Center information technology operational support. All funds received through the EMPG program will be provided on a reimbursable basis and will be matched in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 budget of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management.
- 5. All funds received through the EMPG program will be provided on a reimbursable basis and will be matched by City of Portland general funds.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland an amendment to grant #12-529 from OEM to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City and to execute an amendment to the intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2013/2014 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund 217
Business Area – EM
Bureau Program Expenses– \$10,253.00

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OEM for EMPG grant, award #12-529, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. (City Attorney's Office review is required prior to acceptance of amendments for determination of whether an ordinance is needed.) Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
