

ORDINANCE No.

186659

Replace Code for Public Sewer and Drainage System Permits, Connections and Maintenance Chapter to enhance clarity, consolidate public sewer system requirements, and enhance ease of use. (Ordinance; replace Code Chapter 17.32, amend Code Sections 17.38.030 and 17.38.040).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) is authorized by the Charter to take action to protect the City sewer, storm sewer and drainage systems. The BES Director has been previously authorized and needs to continue to be authorized to require permit application, review and approval of access, modification or addition of new public improvements or connections to these systems.
2. The existing BES permitting code Chapter 17.32 of the Portland City Code (PCC) does not present information in a way that it is clear with what is required for BES public works, connection or other permit types. This proposal reorganizes existing authorities so it is clear what requirements apply to what types of permits.
3. BES is proposing to establish new permit types to be incorporated into the new City Information Technology Advanced Project (ITAP) permit tracking system. These new permit types need to be described in the PCC and may include easement encroachment permits, onsite drainage permits, system access permits, and stormwater management facility-related permits.
4. BES is also proposing updates to its Sewer Backflow Device Reimbursement rules (PPD item ENB-4.08) to reflect latest program criteria and expand eligibility. Program eligibility will expand to any structure impacted or potentially impacted by sewer back-ups regardless of date of structure construction.
5. Notice was provided for this proposal to the Development Review Advisory Committee and the public during the months of April and May 2014. No comments were received and no public hearing was requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. That the proposed replacement Chapter 17.32 and the amended Chapter 17.38 be made as outlined in Attachment A.
- b. That the Director is authorized to amend the Sewer Backflow Device Reimbursement Rules (ENB-4.08) to remove structure construction dates previously established by Council (Ordinances 140285, 151860 and 173295) for program eligibility.



