

Memorandum of Understanding

Arleta Triangle Project (ATP) and Mt. Scott Arleta Neighborhood Association (MSANA)

Areas of Agreement

Volunteers

MSANA will elect annually a designated board member to act as liaison to the ATP.

ATP will designate a volunteer to act as liaison to the MSANA.

ATP will solicit volunteers for upcoming events at MSANA meetings and through other neighborhood association channels.

Communications

The designated ATP volunteer will communicate at least bi-monthly with the Mt Scott Arleta Neighborhood Association's designated liaison board member. Topics will include upcoming events, plans for site maintenance, and future planning discussions.

ATP will post flyers regarding upcoming events, such as work parties, building projects and planning sessions on the MSANA bulletin board (at the Mt. Scott Community Center lobby.)

Insurance

MSANA will, assuming conditions of this MOU are met, provide ATP with the necessary liability insurance available to neighborhood projects through Southeast Uplift.

Financial Support

MSANA may, but is not obligated to, provide neighborhood communications funds or other funding to the Arleta Triangle Project.

Term of Agreement

This agreement will remain in effect until September 30, 2011.
