Until long-term reforms to Title 11 can be developed and adopted, I urge you to:

Require inch-for-inch mitigation for cutting large, healthy, non-dangerous and non-nuisance trees ≥
diameter at breast height "dbh" in development and non-development situations until Title 11 preservation standards can be reformed.

2. Require posting and a 30-day delay before any tree \geq 30" dbh is permitted to be cut.
