TO THE COUNCIL:

On April 13, 2016, Council approved Ordinance Number 187674 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the 2015 Traffic Signal Rebuilds Rebid in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000287 on behalf of the Bureau ofTransportation (PBOT), with a project construction estimate of \$1,002,355. PBOT rated the project estimate confidence level as Optimal.

Bids were opened on May 3, 2016, and three (3) bids were received. The low bid from Tice Electric Company was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Tice Electric Company's bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$1,009,904.23.

PBOT along with Procurement Services, identified fifteen (15) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$471,052.00 awarded to subcontractors.

 WBE - \$316,929 performing Asphalt Paving, Clearing/Grubbing/Mowing/Brushing, Concrete Cutting, Concrete Work, Grading, Landscaping, Sewer, Water & Storm Drain Work, Striping, Traffic Control Services (Includes TPDT).

Tice Electric Company is located in Portland, Oregon, and is not a State Certified D/M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center SAP Cost Object 9TR000000636 and SAP WBS Element T00543.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
