ORDINANCE No. 183434

* Amend subrecipient contract with Cascade AIDS Project in the amount of \$21,500 for Project-Based Rent Assistance for People with HIV/AIDS. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000589)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The City has been awarded funds from the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to fund projects to assist individuals with HIV/AIDS within a seven-county area known as the Portland Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area (EMSA).
- 2. Cascade AIDS Project (CAP) has consistently provided support to the HIV community through an enhanced supportive service program including rent assistance.
- 3. The Portland Housing Bureau budgeted an additional \$21,500 in HOPWA funds for additional rent assistance in the FY 2009-10 Fall BUMP process.
- 4. Total compensation under this amended contract shall not exceed \$812,478.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. PHB's Director and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter a formal agreement with CAP in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to make payment chargeable to the FY 2009-10 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt CAP's ability to carry out the project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
