ORDINANCE No. 183435

*Amend the Intergovernmental Agreement template used between Portland Park & Recreation and the Portland Development Commission for professional, technical and construction services. (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 181232)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R), in partnership with the Portland Development Commission (PDC), is planning, developing, and implementing parks, natural areas, and recreation facilities improvements within the designated urban renewal districts.
- 2. PP&R and PDC, under their respective charter authorities, are authorized to enter into cooperative agreements for the improvement of the community.
- 3. As the City's bureau responsible for recreation, PP&R will plan, design, and construct parks, natural areas, and recreation facilities improvements in various urban renewal districts.
- 4. PP&R will develop these projects, along with PDC, with open public involvement processes, and work with Purchasing to promote diversity efforts in contracting the work.
- 5. PP&R will perform this work by providing a high level of service to the community, and seek efficiencies in projects through inter bureau collaboration in the design process.
- 6. PP&R and PDC have developed a single year and multi-year intergovernmental agreement template for professional, technical, and construction services for parks, nature, and recreation facilities improvements, to be used for each project agreement.
- 7. PP&R and PDC have modified the intergovernmental agreement template to update the language related to Business and Workforce Equity and Percent for Art Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Council hereby delegates to the Director of the Portland Parks & Recreation the authority to execute single and multi-year Intergovernmental Agreements between Portland Parks & Recreation and the Portland Development Commission, to provide professional, technical, and construction services for parks, nature, and recreation facilities improvements, similar in form to the agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance, and by this reference made a part hereof, with approval of the City Auditor and City Attorney.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there are a number of capital projects that do not currently have IGA's. Emergency passage of the new template will allow projects to proceed without further delay. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
