ORDINANCE No. 183437

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreements for implementation of Grey to Green ecoroof projects (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City manages stormwater as a resource under the Portland Watershed Management Plan (PWMP). In November of 2007 the Grey to Green (G2G) Initiative was launched to accelerate some principle elements of the PWMP implementation.
- 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) currently has a program to construct ecoroofs. The G2G initiative will expand and augment the existing ecoroof program.
- 3. BES plans to budget approximately \$4.5 million over the next five fiscal years (FY09 FY13) to facilitate the G2G ecoroof effort.
- 4. A goal of the Ecoroof program is to foster the use of ecoroofs throughout Portland. The G2G initiative has a target of adding 43 acres of new ecoroof area to the City of Portland over the FY2009- FY2013 period.
- 5. Individual agreements with property owners are necessary in order to achieve this target. Council approved individual agreements with private property owners last year and BES would also like to the opportunity to enter into intergovernmental agreements with other government agencies.
- 6. \$40,000 is available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2009-10 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, [9ESWS0000055], project number [various]. Additional appropriations for FY 2010 13 will be available in the same operating fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute intergovernmental agreements, to the extent budgeted funds are available, for the Grey to Green Ecoroof Program projects in a form substantially similar to the template agreement attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance and for the purpose described in Section 1 of this ordinance.

- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute amendments that do not increase the original amount of each agreement by more than 10%.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget and when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
